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46. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES.

The Minutes of the Fourth Meeting held on 3rd July, 1963, were confirmed.

47. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES.

The National Flag (Minute 38).

It was AGREED that as soon as the final design of the flag had been seen and approved by the Prime Minister, the Minister for Justice should proceed to publicise it and the Minister for Works should arrange its production after calling for tenders.

48. INDEPENDENCE STAMP ISSUE.

In pursuance of Minute 39, Mr. Moore displayed a fresh series of designs of the Independence Stamp issue.

THE CABINET AGREED

(1) that the fresh designs be accepted, but that:

(i) the 65 cent stamp should depict the pyrethrum industry;

(ii) the 20 cent stamp should depict the timber industry (i.e. a general forest scene, with felled logs, trees and people) and not the milling industry; and

(iii) the 30 cent stamp should be as proposed by Mr. Moore, but that the mountain should be moved to the left of the picture, that the head and shoulders of the Prime Minister should appear on the right of the picture, and that the caption should be "Facing Mount Kenya"; and

(2) that the Minister for Justice take the necessary action.
